The criteria for selecting the right eye protection, includes:



Frequency of use



Environment



Activities performed



Individual worker needs

Fit & Compatibility:

1. Ensure a proper fit to ensure maximum safety.
2. Eye protection must be compatible with other personal protective equipment (PPE), such as face masks, helmets, and earmuffs.

Understanding Potential Hazard

Identify the various types of hazards present in the workplace, including UV exposure, infrared exposure, particulates, and chemical splashes prior to selecting eye protection.



Remind your team not to wipe eye protection with their Conti Suits as this causes damage and reduces visibility.

Ensure regular training, open communication about safety concerns, and encourage reporting of issues with PPE.
