Effective Implementation of LOTO

Successful Lockout Tagout (LOTO) implementation involves a systematic approach:

01.,0

Prepare for Shutdown: Identify all energy sources and inform affected employees.



Disconnect and Isolate: Shutdown equipment and apply lockout devices to prevent accidental re-energization.

03.

Verify Isolation: Test to ensure energy sources are properly locked out before starting maintenance.



Document Procedures: Keep detailed records of LOTO activities, including who performed them and what steps were taken.

05.

Regular training and audits of LOTO procedures to maintain compliance and safety.
